

RACE INFORMATION



COURSE & DISTANCE

This year the Moose Chase will be entirely set on the Shooting Star property and will feature 25km of flat to gentle rolling terrain with classic views of our valley. Inspection of the course is free of charge and available ONLY on Friday, February 13th from 10am – 4pm.

All participants must finish by 12pm in order to receive a time.

TIME & PLACE

All race starts will be south of the new entrance road to Teton Village. Start will be clearly marked and is visible from the road.

Half Moose Chase(12km) ~ 10:05 am
Mini Moose Chase(5km) ~ 10:10 am
